Q. Seriously, no cost?

2. You must have a high school diploma or a GED and have not attended college before.
3. You must not be in default on a student loan.
4. You must be serious about using the trial course as a stepping stone toward earning a degree online.

Q. What happens if I stop attending the course or withdraw?

A. If you stop attending the course or withdraw, you will lose your spot in the Put Us to the Test program. You will not be eligible to re-enroll in this program but you are still eligible to apply for Admission to Bryant & Stratton College Online.

Q. How long does the essay have to be? What do I have to write about?

A. The essay is simply a short description about why you believe you are a good candidate for online education and why you are interested in the degree program of your choice. Successful essays range from 350x to 500x words.

Q. Am I going to have anyone to help me if I have questions or need help?

A. In addition to having access to our technical support team, you will also have an assigned Support Specialist who will check in with you throughout the course and be available if you need anything.
